5. a recommendation letter from the highest authority responsible for the tourism sector of the World Tourism Organization foreign member country
6. CV of the applicant (contacts and e-mail of applicant for further connection);
7. Language proficiency certificate (IELTS 5.5, CEFR - B2, TOEFL IBM-72 score); (If the applicant graduated from a university where the language education was English, a certificate is not required.)

The following candidates cannot participate in the competition:

1. the person is over 45 years old at the time of document submission and has previously upgraded their qualifications in a similar specialty abroad;
2. members of the diplomatic and consular corps or family members of representatives of the diplomatic and consular corps accredited in the Republic of Uzbekistan;
3. administrative and technical staff of diplomatic missions and consular institutions accredited in the Republic of Uzbekistan;
4. staff of international organizations located in the Republic of Uzbekistan

V.	<p>Procedure for conducting the competition:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The selection committee review the documents submitted by the competition participants. 2. Based on the collected documents, the selection committee conducts an interview with the competition participants regarding their professional knowledge and skills, personal and professional characteristics, and abilities. 3. List of competition winners will be announced on the Academy's official website. 4. If the competition winner does not participate in the educational process within one month after the start of the educational process, i.e., cannot arrive at the Academy, grant funds will not be allocated to them. 5. Between the competition winner and the Academy will be concluded a contract, specifying the conditions for organizing the educational process and the obligations of the parties. <p>Note: Competition participants are entitled to file an appeal with the Appeals Commission within three days of the interview results being published. In the event that the Appeals Commission determines that procedural errors, deficiencies, or a lack of transparency have occurred during the competition process or the interview phase by the Selection Committee members, the Commission will re-conduct the interview with the participants or recalculate their results.</p>
VI.	<p>The grant will be allocated to cover the following expenses of the specialists:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a monthly scholarship and living expenses equivalent to 500 US dollars; 2. one-time expenses related to travel, getting acquainted with the culture and life of the regions of Uzbekistan, equivalent to 100 US dollars; 3. expenses for one-time economy class travel to Uzbekistan and return to their home country.
